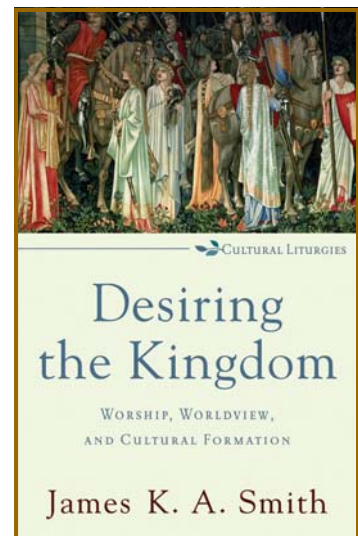

The speaker for this semester's *Athens and Jerusalem Seminar Lecture* is James K. A. Smith. Dr. Smith studied philosophy at the Villanova University and currently serves as Associate Professor of Philosophy at Calvin College. His administrative efforts have included serving as the Director of Calvin College's highly influential Seminars in Christian Scholarship.

Dr. Smith is the author or editor of over ten books. His most recent book, is *Desiring the Kingdom: Worship, Worldview, and Cultural Formation*. This volume is the first in his three-volume Cultural Liturgies Series with Baker Academic and examines the role that the Christian college or university can have in terms of how it forms more than just the minds of students.
