

John Wesley Scholars Program Curricular Requirements

In order to graduate from the Honors College as a John Wesley Scholar, a student must complete the following course requirements (36-42 hrs). The curricular requirements of John Wesley Scholars do not constitute a major or minor, but rather they fulfill many requirements in the General Education curricula. For example, all IWU students are required to take courses in the Humanities Core, but John Wesley Scholars take those courses as honors sections.

John Wesley Scholars also work collaboratively with faculty members on research projects (Honors Research Tutorials), think seriously about their life calling (Liberal Learning/Life Calling Portfolio), consider the importance of the arts in a Christian life well-lived (Honors Forum), participate in honors courses of their choosing (Honors Electives—these often fulfill additional General Education requirements), and complete a research project in an area of interest within their major (Honors Research/Creativity Competency).
